TOPIC: PUBLIC HEARING TO AMEND GENERAL BUDGET – OFFICE OF
HIGHWAY SAFETY PLANNING “MACP AWARD GRANT.”

In February, 2005 the Michigan Office of Highway Safety Planning, in partnership with the Michigan Association of Chiefs of Police and AAA Michigan, recognized the Midland Police Department traffic services program as one of the finest programs in the State of Michigan by presenting the department with their annual “Excellence in Traffic Safety Award.” As part of the award presentation the Midland Police Department was awarded a \$1,000.00 grant, known as the “MACP Award Grant”, to be used as the police department chooses towards any traffic safety issue.

The Midland Police department has chosen to utilize the “MACP Award Grant” to purchase advanced equipment used in the investigation of serious traffic accidents.

In order for the Midland Police Department to utilize the grant funding towards the expense of purchasing the traffic accident investigation equipment there is a need to conduct a Public Hearing by the City Council. On May 23, 2005 the City Council set a public hearing for the June 13, 2005 City Council meeting for the purpose of providing an opportunity for public input as to the proposal of amending the 2004-05 General Fund Budget by increasing the budget’s revenues by \$1,000.00 and to increase expenditures by \$1,000.00
