SUBJECT: MDOT Contract No. 06-5179  
Bike Path, Jefferson Avenue to the Midland Mall

Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) Contract No. 06-5179 is between the City and MDOT for construction of a bike path from Jefferson Avenue to the Midland Mall. The total estimated construction cost for this project is \$170,800. The City Engineering Department secured a transportation enhancement grant in the amount of \$91,630 through MDOT. The City is responsible for the remaining balance amounting to \$79,170.

This project is scheduled for construction this summer, and consists of installation of a 10 foot wide paved bike path with related storm sewer and fencing improvements. The attached map indicates the bike path route. This project was previously approved by Council during the annual engineering project priorities process.

An earlier phase of this project included installation of a bike path on the Jefferson Avenue overpass and creating an east/west connection to the soccer fields. This work was completed as part of an MDOT bridge repair project of the Jefferson Avenue overpass in 2002.

This contract has been reviewed by the City Attorney as to form.

It is recommended that this contract be approved by City Council and the Mayor and City Clerk be authorized to sign the contract on behalf of the City of Midland following final approval by the City Attorney.

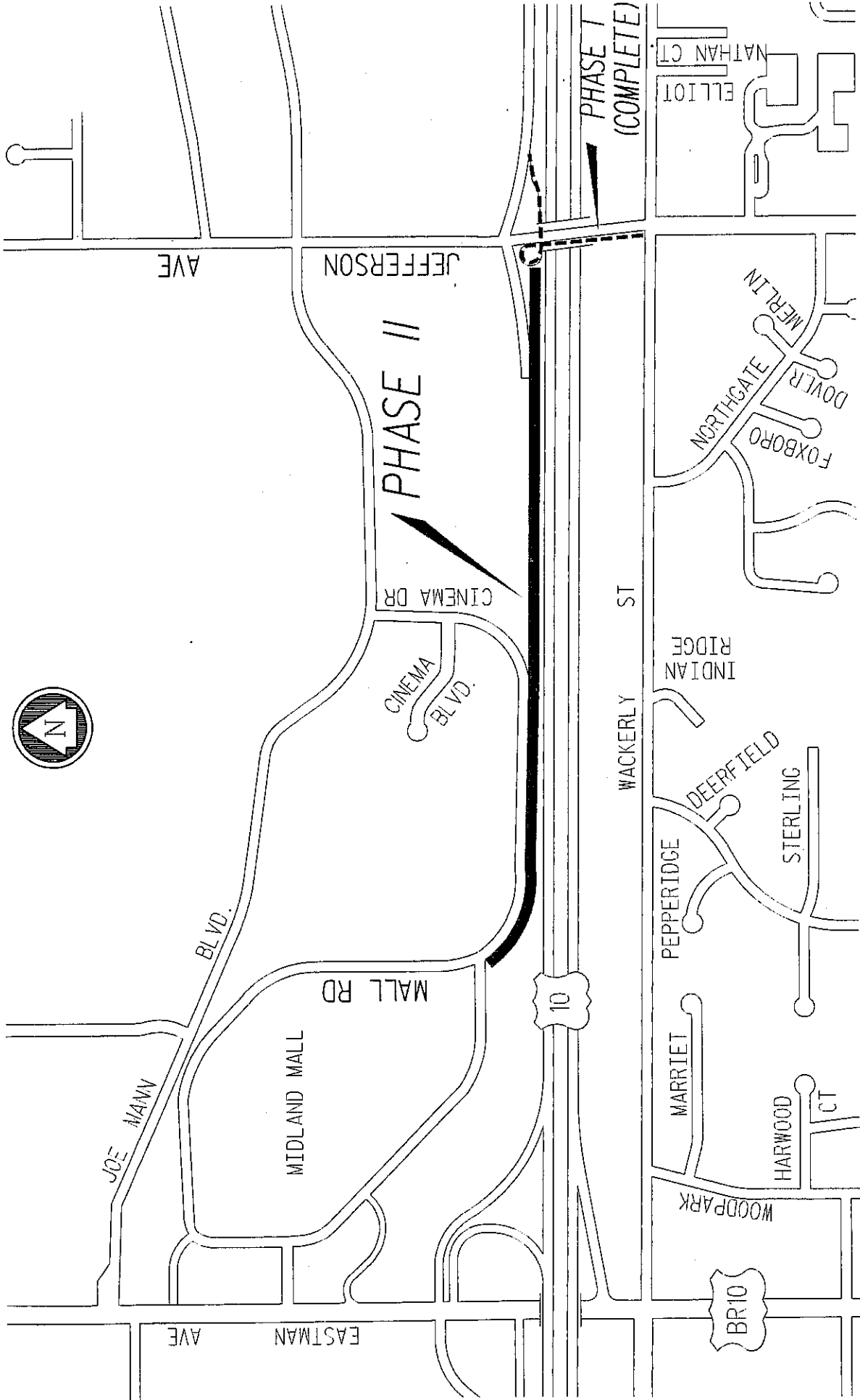
