Brush & Heavy Item Collection Program

What to Set Out

- boxes of any size
- carpeting
- scrap metal
- asphalt
- furniture
- mattresses
- appliances: remove covers and doors
- demolition: remodeling and building materials, from occupied residences only
- branches, tree trimmings and brush, from occupied residences only: cut into eight foot lengths or less
- tires: maximum of four per year

Items That Are Not Collected

- old car bodies, car parts, and batteries
- chemicals, household hazardous materials
- explosives and live ammunition
- dead animals
- loose soil and sod
- liquid paint

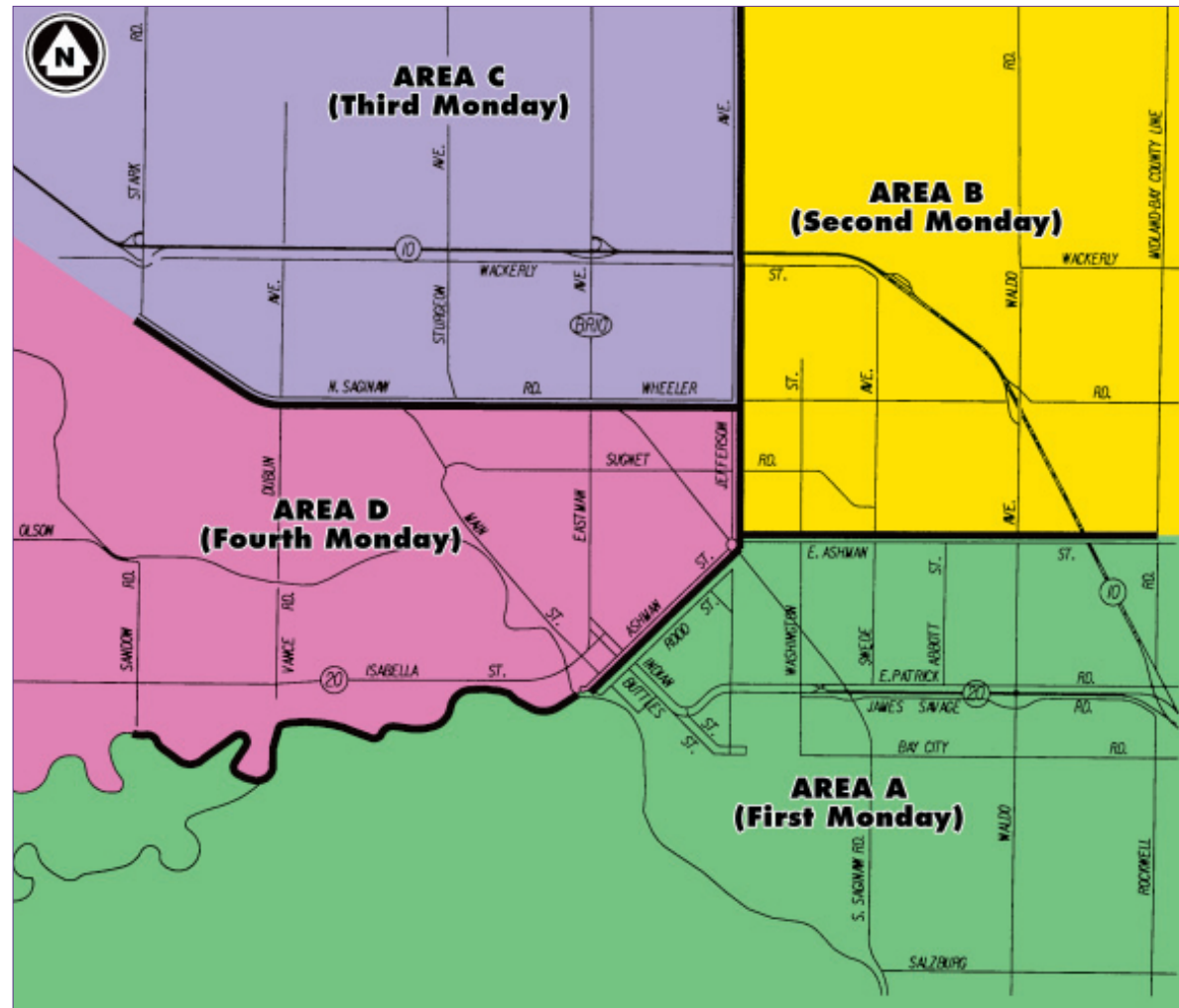
When to Set Out Items

Place brush/heavy items at the curb by 8 a.m. on the Monday of your area's scheduled collection week. Items may be set at the curb no earlier than the Saturday prior to your collection Monday. Items placed earlier than Saturday may be subject to a fine of \$50 or more. Collection for each area begins on Monday and will continue until completed within that week.

Any container placed at the curb for heavy item collection will be disposed of.

How To Prepare

Keep brush and household items in clearly separated piles. Avoid placing items near poles, hydrants, trees, signs, wires, mailboxes, and other obstacles. All items, including brush, must be less than 8 ft. in length, with a one-foot space between piles. Items or brush should never be placed in the street. Don't fill cardboard boxes with debris, as boxes will break down and fall apart.

Your Brush & Heavy Item Collection Is the Fourth Monday of Each Month

Borrow-A-Container

A 4x6x4 (4 cubic yards) dumpster can be reserved by residential customers for overnight loading. A dumpster is placed on either your outlawn or driveway approach before 3:30 p.m. and collected the following morning. Friday reservations may load over the weekend for Monday



morning pickup. Residents can reserve up to four dumpsters per year. Reservations are required as the dumpsters are available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Due to disposal regulations, dumpsters can be filled with either brush or refuse, but not both. Dumpsters cannot be used for yard waste. Call 989-837-6900 to reserve a container.
