Help Keep Our Community Safe... The Midland Police Department offers free crime prevention programs to city residents. For information on these and other crime prevention services, call the department's Community Relations Officer at 989-839-4648.

Traffic Services... Traffic safety is a priority of Midland City Council and the Police Department. This emphasis led to the creation of the Traffic Services Unit in August 2001.

Through safe driving programs and educational opportunities, the Traffic Services Unit works diligently to make Midland's streets safer.

Two full-time traffic enforcement



officers help to round out the Traffic Services Unit. Officers conduct selective traffic enforcement throughout the city and deal with traffic enforcement issues by patrolling areas known to be problematic. They also respond to citizen traffic complaints in localized areas.

Neighborhood / Business Watch...

These programs encourage citizens to assist in safeguarding Midland by being on the lookout for suspicious or illegal activity. Program members are trained how to identify and report on crimes such as larceny, breaking and entering, and credit card theft. Call 989-839-4648 for details.

School Resources... School resource officers are now located at both H. H. Dow and Midland high schools. These officers will be responsible for all calls at the school, serve as the department's D.A.R.E. officials, and offer other law enforcement education programming to students at high, middle, and elementary schools.

Midland Fire Department (989) 837-3410

The Midland Fire Department consists of three stations located in the city. For questions or information about smoke detectors, fire safety, and prevention, visit the department's website at www.midland-mi.org or call 989-837-3410.

Burning Regulations... Recreational fires are permitted within the city limits, but certain rules apply. Fires must be no more than three feet in diameter and three feet high. Use clean firewood only. Burning leaves, brush, trash, or garbage is prohibited. All recreational fires should be kept at least 25 feet away from any building. Keep a shovel, garden hose, or fire extinguisher with a minimum 4A rating available to extinguish the fire if necessary. All fires must be constantly attended by a responsible person.

Emergency Siren Tests... Emergency warning siren system tests are routinely conducted. A short, weekly "growl test" occurs Saturdays at 12:45 p.m., with a full monthly test occurring the first Saturday of each month. Tests ensure that sirens work properly.
