Parks & Recreation Facilities

Outdoor Park Shelters Chippewassee Park:** Capacity: 75 people.
Emerson Park: 3 shelters, Capacity: 150, 75 and 75. Also 5 unsheltered areas with a capacity of 75 people each.
Plymouth Park: 3 shelters, Capacity: 200, 75 and 75. Also 2 unsheltered areas with capacity for 75 each.
Barstow Woods: Capacity: 75.
Stratford Woods: Capacity: 50. Each shelter has grills and electricity. Available: April 15 - October 15. See the January calendar for details on reserving picnic shelters.



City Forest Chalet** Capacity: 50. Amenities: fireplace, picnic table seating for up to 50 guests, kitchen/serving area with refrigerator, outdoor deck with charcoal grills (you supply the charcoal), and indoor restrooms. Available: April 15 - October 15.

Conference Rooms at Grace A. Dow Memorial Library*** Capacity: up to 20 in each of three rooms. Available: year-round. Various audio/visual equipment available for rent.

Currie Clubhouse

Dial-A-Ride Transportation System (DART) provides public transportation within Midland's city limits. All busses are lift-equipped to accommodate various mobility devices. Rides are booked on a first-call, first-served basis.

Call DART at least 60 minutes before you need to be picked up, and plan on a 25-minute bus ride to your destination. Ride times may be longer during the busiest hours.
