

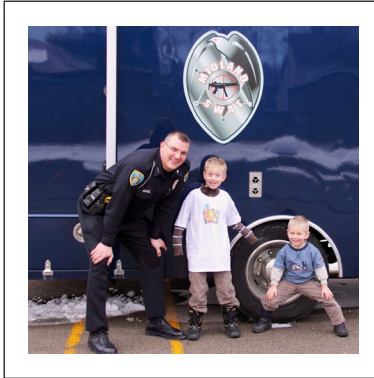

Crime Prevention...

Prevention is the department's highest priority. Through community partnerships, crime prevention programming, and safe driving initiatives, the department works diligently to make Midland's streets safer.

Working in unison with the Patrol Division, the department's Crime Prevention Unit has created and participates in numerous area programs. In addition to prevention, they also assist in building relationships with local businesses, organizations, and citizens.



If You See Something, Say Something... Midland Police urges citizens, business owners, and their employees to report any suspicious activities they see in their neighborhoods or business areas. Neighborhood / Business Watch...

These programs encourage citizens to assist in safeguarding Midland by being on the lookout for suspicious or illegal activity. Program members are trained how to identify and report on crimes such as larceny, breaking and entering, and credit card theft. Call 989-839-4648 for details.

School Resources... School resource officers are now located at both H. H. Dow and Midland high schools. These officers are responsible for all police calls at the school, serve as the department's D.A.R.E. officers, and offer law enforcement education to students at all grade levels.

The Midland Fire Department consists of three stations located in the city. For information about smoke detectors, fire safety, and prevention, visit www.midland-mi.org or call 989-837-3410.

Burning Regulations... Recreational fires are permitted within the city limits, but certain rules apply. Fires must be no more than three feet in diameter and three feet high. Use clean firewood only. Burning leaves, brush, trash, or garbage is prohibited. All recreational fires should be kept at least 25 feet away from any building. Keep a shovel, garden hose, or fire extinguisher with a minimum 4A rating handy to extinguish the fire if necessary. All fires must be constantly attended by a responsible person.

Emergency Siren Tests... A short, weekly "growl test" is conducted each Saturday at 12:45 p.m., with a full monthly test occurring the first Saturday of each month. Tests ensure that sirens work properly.
